



Pursuant to a Contract of the 1<sup>st</sup> of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1827. with the members of the Board of Property of the State of Pennsylvania & the Authority therein, the Above Tract of land was Surveyed & Calculated by virtue of App<sup>r</sup> No 3675 granted by the proprietary government to John Gibson 25<sup>th</sup> July 1769. Containing three Hundred & thirty two acres Twenty one perch  $\frac{8}{10}$  & all<sup>s</sup>. Situate in Finley Township Allegheny County.

Note the above Survey includes all the Survey Executed for William Wilson assignee of Sam<sup>l</sup> Cook Calling for 343 acs & all<sup>s</sup> on a Branch of Racon Creek. Excepting the oblong adj<sup>t</sup> Jos<sup>s</sup> Tarrance marked with the letters - W. W.
