The dotted lines and the letters A B C D & E in the above diagram represent a Survey made to James Miller on the 16th day of February 1828 A return whereof is herewith enclosed. The Location has been laid upon the land described by the location in the forks of Blacklick Creek about a mile above the forks. - It will be seen by the above diagram that the land has been previously appropriated & Surveyed and part of it Patented. - John McCrea owns and occupies a part of this tract & claims under the title to Samuel Porten in trust &c. The balance of it is claimed by James Mitchell under the title to Peter Wallace and himself.
