At the Request of Rebeckah Shaw Daughter of Robt Barrow late of Kendal in ye County of Westmoreland Mason (by her friend Thomas Barnes) That We would Grant her to take up Three Hundred Acres of Land in this Province Granted by the Proprietor to Y^e Said Robert her Father now deceased by Deeds dated the 14th & 15th Days of June A.D. 1682: These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd in the Right aforesaid according to the Method of Townships appointed the Said quantity of Three Hundred Acres of Land in this Province that has not been already Survey'd nor Appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our Hands and Seal of the Province the 8th day of the first Month A.D. 1713/4
