This land is entirely the same which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Rudebush alias Frowl bush dated the 18 October 1738 and Patented on the 15 of April 1790. Martin Free was the owner and in possession of the above but when he took out his application knew nothing of the old warrant. Now owned and occupied by Philip Lauer
