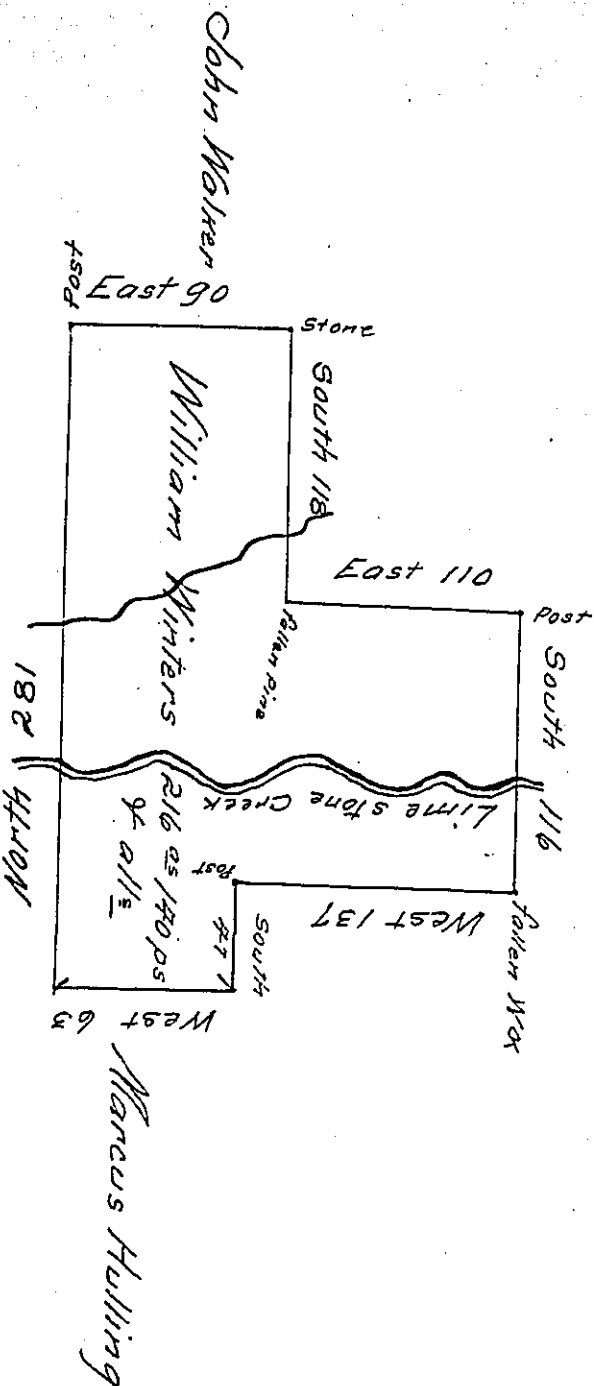


Col. Francis Long

Situate in Turbut Township Northumberland County Surveyed on the 23rd day of October A.D. 1836 by Virtue of an Order dated the 19th day of June 1769 No 3515 granted to William Winters. Containing Two hundred & Sixteen acres & One hundred and forty perches with the usual allowance &c

Note the Same tract of land was Surveyed on the day of A.D. 17 for Benjamin Dean in pursuance of his Order dated the 28th day of June A.D. 1769^{No 3575} and is now owned and Occupied by W. Shanick & others in right of Said Benjamin Dean.
