



Pursuant to a Contract of the first of Novr 1827 with the members of the Board of Property of the State of Penna & the authority therein, the above Tract of Land was Surveyed & Calculated, by Virtue of Appn No 3412, granted to Peter Smelser by the proprietary government 13th June 1769. Containing two hundred Acres & fourteen perches & All^s Situate in the Township of Pitt & Wilkins, the Township lines runs through the Tract in Allegheny County.
