


Done, / Morchands heirs



In pursuance of an application granted to Gustavus Gregory No ~~3369~~ 3424 dated 13th of June 1769 Surveyed the above described tract of Land on the 9th day of August 1828 Containing three hundred and Six Acres one hundred and two perches and the allowance proportioned at Six percent for Roads &c. Situate including a South branch of little Sewickly on both sides of Braddock road in Hempfield township in the County of Westmoreland.
