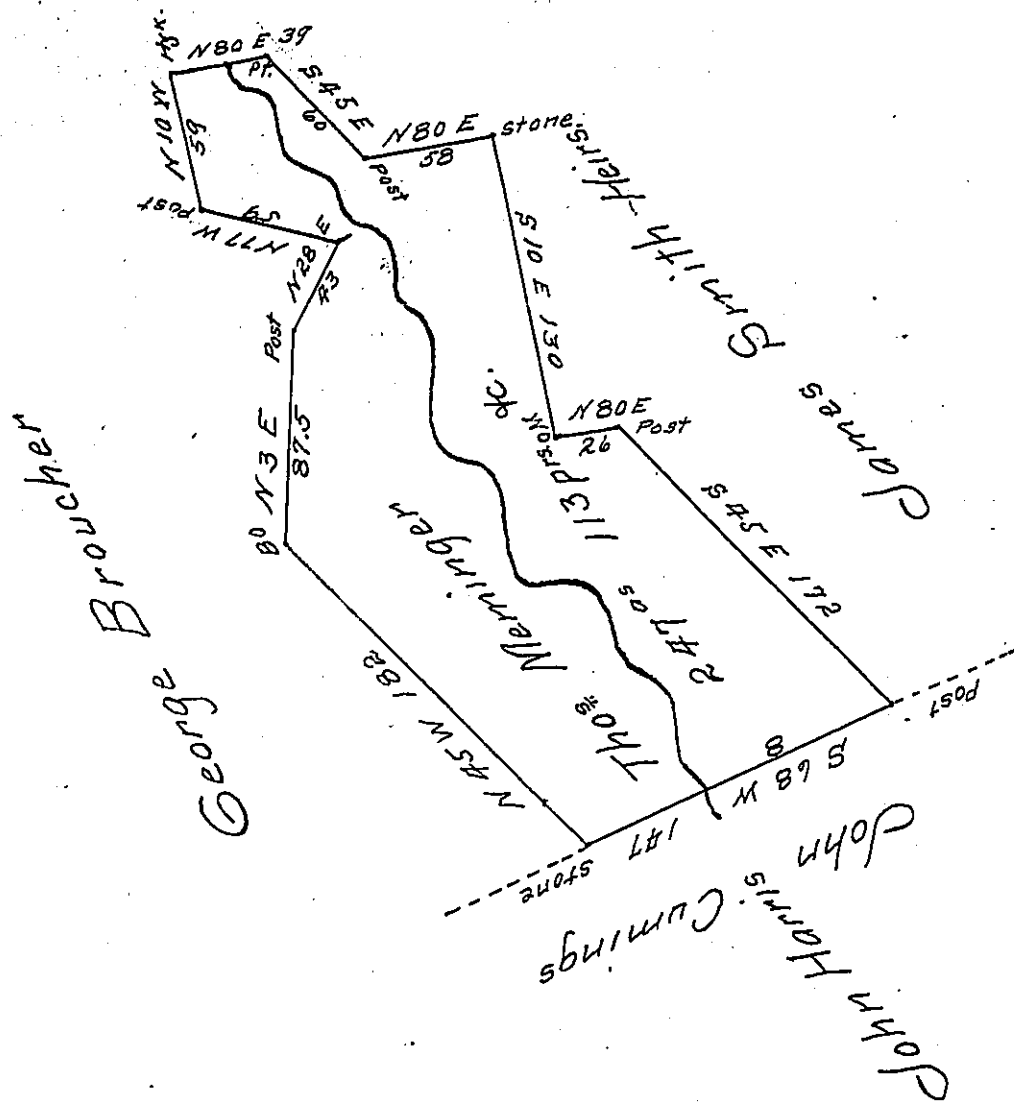

Note The same tract of land was Surveyed the 5th day of October 1769 for Jacob Landes in pursuance of his order Dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 2095 And now owned & occupied by Jacob Jenger in right of the said Jacob Landes.
