


FORM NO. 1.

Thomas Meminger dated the 11th day of April 1769, Containing
two Hundred & forty Seven Acres & one hundred & thirteen perches

Note The same tract of land was Surveyed the 5th day of
October 1769 for Jacob Landes in pursuance of his order
Dated the 3^d day of April 1769 No. 2095 And now owned &
occupied by Jacob Venger in right of the said Jacob Landes.
