

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary and Governour bearing date the 21st day of 8^{br} 1701 to lay out unto Andreas Rudman and Company ten Thousand acres of land Near Maxatawny on y^e River Schuylkil There is Surveyd unto the said Andreas Rudman five hundred acres in the place aforesaid Part of th^e Said ten thousand acres Beginning at a Post by the River Schuylkil at the Corner of the Proprietarys land Thence North twenty degrees east by the line of the Proprietarys land one thousand two hundred and thirty perches to a post Then East South east Sixty five perches to a post Then South twenty degrees west by the line of Peter Boons land one thousand two hundred and eighteen perches to a post by the River Schuylk Then up the several Courses of the Same to the place of Beginning Containing five hundred acres as above sd
