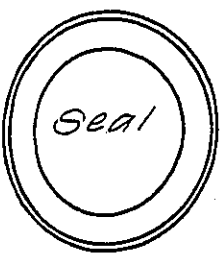

At the Request of Silas Crispin Exec^t of the last will & Testam^t of Thomas Holme deceased That we would grant him to take up the quantity of five hundred acres of Land remaining un- taken up of Eleven thousand Acres purchased by the Sd Thomas of the Proprietarie and of Original Purchasers under him: These are to Authorize and Require thee to survey and lay out to the sd Silas Crispin ~~the~~ ~~sd~~ according to the Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of five hundred acres of Land that has not been already surveyd nor taken up nor is conceal'd ob^l seated by the Indians, and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 9th day of 8^{br} 1704
