Philadelphia bearing date the 31st of the 8th Month 1684. another for

Moth 1684. - The said Joshua Cart requesting that wee would grant
him one warrant in Lue of the fforementioned two, to take up Sev-
en hundred acres of Land in what County he shall thinke most
Convenient within this Province, - These are therefore in the Proprie-
tarys Name to will and require thee fforthwith to survey or cause to be
Surveyed unto him the Said number of acres in ^{any of} the afore Said Countys;
where not already taken upp, according to the method of Townships
appointed by the Govern^t. He seating & Improveing the same, within Six
months after the Date of Survey and make returne hereof to the Secretarys
Office Dated at Philadelphia the 3^d of the 3^d month Ann^o Dom 1686.
