And make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv'd to thee cer- tified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^a the 4th of y^e 2^d Moth 1706.
