At the Request of Samuel Carpenter that I would grant
him to take up two hundred and ffour foot of Land upon
and before the Bank of Delaware River Containing in
Breadth the front of his owne & Christopher Taylers Lotts
and begining upon the Bounds of the ffirst Street upon the sd
Banke Sixty foot distant from the front of his owne & Chris-
topher Taylers Lotts & Running out in Length into the River
two hundred and fifty foot & no further. he makeing a
wharfe & Building according to Regulation. These are to
will and Require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be Sur-
veyed unto him the sd Number of ffet & make Returns
thereof Into my Secretarys office. Given at Philadel-
phia the 7th of the 2^d Month 1684.
