By virtue of a warrant from y<sup>e</sup> Proprietary and govern<sup>t</sup> dated y<sup>e</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1683 directed to y<sup>e</sup> Survey<sup>r</sup> Generall I do by Authority from him Certifie into y<sup>e</sup> Secretarys office that there was Surveyed and Laid out y<sup>e</sup> same day unto Samuel Carpenter (Purchas<sup>r</sup> of ffive Thousand acres) his Lott in y<sup>e</sup> Libertys of Philadelphia Beginning at a Corner white oak Standing near unto a Small Runn being A Corner of Thomas ffairmans Land thence E.N.E. by a line of trees one hundred and ffive perches thence S.S.E. by a line of trees one hundred Thirty Eight p<sup>ch</sup>es to a Corner post being a Corner of Robert Turners Land thence W.S.W. by Bowyers Land ffifty ffour perches to a Corn<sup>r</sup> tree thereof Standing by y<sup>e</sup> afore mentioned Runn thence ffollowing along y<sup>e</sup> Severall Courses thereof to y<sup>e</sup> place of beginning containing Eighty acres of Land, which is accordingly Entred and Record<sup>d</sup> in y<sup>e</sup> Survey<sup>r</sup> Generalls office at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>d</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1691
