By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary and Governour bearing date the 21st of 8^{br} 1701 for Laying out unto Andreas Rudman for the use of himself and several of the Swedes ten thousand acres of land There is Surveyd and laid out unto Otto Earnest Cook five hundred acres of land (part of the Said Ten thousand acres) situate near Manatawny on the East Side of Schuyl Kill in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a post by ^e River Schuyl Kill at the Corner of Morton Morton's land Then by the line of the Said Morton Morton's land North twenty degrees East one Thousand one hundred and fifty One perches to a post Then by vacant land East South East Sixty eight perches to a post Then by the line of Rich^d Roads ~~land~~ land South twenty degrees West One Thousand and one hundred and Eighty perches to Schuyl Kill River Then up the same on the Courses thereof to the Beginning Surveyd by David Powel the 28th day of J^e 5th 1704.
