At the Request of William Clark of Lewis in the County of Sussex and in pursuance of the Proprietors Grant under his hand These are to require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the Said William Clark a small piece of vacant Land lying at the lower end of the Said William's Lott in Chestnut Street in y^e City of Philad^{ia} bounded by the Sd Lott and Walnut Street^{Lotts} of equal Breadth with his Sd Lott and Depth about forty or fifty foot at the Yearly rent of five Shillings

And make Return thereof into the Secretary Office Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadel-phia the twenty fourth day of November 1701.
