At y<sup>e</sup> Request of Edmond Cartlidge, y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him to take up a Lott w<sup>th</sup>in y<sup>e</sup> City of Philadelphia proportionable to his Purchase of Two hundred & fifty Acres:

These are to will and require three forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him <sup>in Delaware</sup> a Lott in y<sup>e</sup> Streets sett out for Purchasers of y<sup>e</sup> like Quantity, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office Given at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> 1683.
