At y<sup>e</sup> Request of James Claypool y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him  
to take up his Proportion of Land within y<sup>e</sup> Liberties of y<sup>e</sup>  
City. These are to will & require three forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or  
cause to be surveyd unto him so much Land in y<sup>e</sup> Bounds  
of y<sup>e</sup> same, as may answer his Purchase as near to y<sup>e</sup>  
City as may be, not yet taken up, & make returns thereof  
into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup>  
1683.
