ing date y^e 12th of y^e 8th moth 1683. directed to me I hereby
Certifie into His Secretaryes office y^t I have caused to be surveyed
and layd oute y^e 21st of y^e 9th moth 1683 unto Joshua Cart
in right of Edward Martingdale Purchas^r of one Thousand
acres. A Certaine peece or parcell of Land Scituate lying &
being in y^e County of Philadelphia - (being part of y^e said
purchase) begining at a Corn^r marked poste standing by
a Streete or Roade, from thence S: E along y^e said Street or
Road 100 perches to a Corn^r post, Thence S. W by Jn^o Barnes
Land 480 perches to a Corn^r marked post, from thence N: W by
a line of marked trees 100 perches to a Corn^r marked post from
thence N: E by y^e Widdow Shorters Land 480 perches to y^e first
mentioned place of begining, Containeing and laid oute as above
for Three hundred Acres of Land, And is accordingly Entred and
Recorded in my office at Philadelphia this 16th of y^e 2^d moth 1686.
