white oak in Shakamaxunch Line, thence N.E. by a line  
of trees 160 p<sup>ches</sup> to franckford Creek thence down  
the Severall Courses thereof to a corner tree Standing  
near y<sup>e</sup> same thence w.s.w by a line of trees 180 p<sup>ches</sup>  
to y<sup>e</sup> place of beginning Containing 40 acres of Land  
which is accordingly Entred and Record<sup>d</sup> in y<sup>e</sup> Sur-  
vey<sup>r</sup> Generalls office at Philadelphia
