There Was Survey'd and laid out the 28th day of the 5th Month 1704 unto Peter Cock three hundred acres of land on the East side ~~of this~~ of Schuylkil in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a post by Schuylkil river Then running North twenty degrees easterly by the line of Matthias Holstor's land One thousand one hundred and thirty five perches to a post Then by vacant land East south east forty two perches to a post Then by the line of Andrew Bankson's land south twenty degrees west One thousand one hundred and ten perches to Schuylkil river Then up the Same on Several Courses to the Beginning
