Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 18<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month 1701 specifying that Whereas Joshua Carpenter hath purchased of the Persons to whom they were laid out or their Assigns all the right to the High Street Lotts on the South side between the Sixth and Seventh Streets from the River Delaware, one small part of a Lott of about twenty eight foot in breadth only excepted, which he has also requested the said Proprietary and Governour to grant in order to compleat to him the whole square: Therefore requiring me forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed to the said Joshua Carpenter the said vacant part of a Lott within the said square in lieu of the like quantity in the same Street to be by him resigned to the said Proprietary and Governour I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed to the said Joshua Carpenter the said part of a Lott containing in breadth twenty eight feet and in length three hundred and six feet being bounded Northward with the High Street Eastward with a Lott which Robert Turner bought of the Commissioners of Property Southward with part of the Square leading from the said Lott to Chestnut Street and Westward with James Boyden's Lott. Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month 1701. & Returned according to the abovesaid survey, and bounds into the Proprietary & Governour's Secretary's Office the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month 1701.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this first day of December 1909.
