into his offic^t that I have Surveyd and Laid out unto Nathaniel Pugle
a Certaine tract of Land in the County of Philadelphia begining
at a Corner post deviding it from Richard Harris Land from thence
North East 500 perches by a Line of marked trees to another
post sett in the ground hard by a w^t oke marked from thence by
a Line of marked trees North West 96 perches to a corner stak deviding
it from Joseph Taners Land from thence by a line of marked trees
South West 500 perches to another corner post deviding it from
Joseph Taners Land from thence by a line of marked trees
South East 96 perches to the place of begining Containing and
Laid out for three hundred acers of Land the 21st 2^d mo 1701
