Whereas the Propriet^{or} at his last Departure ^{from this Province} Granted unto David Powel Survey^r a Certain Tract or Parcel of Land to be taken up in the S^d Province at the Rate of ten pounds p Hundred and the usual Yearly Quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for Each Hundred Acres for Ever. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or Cause to be Survey'd unto the Said David Powel in part of the Said Grant the Quantity of Two Hundred Acres of Land in the Said Province That is not already Survey'd nor Appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make a Returne into the Secretary's Office in Order to a further Confirmation.

Given Under our hands and Seale of the Province at Philadelphia the th 26 day of the ffifth Month Anno Dni 1714.
