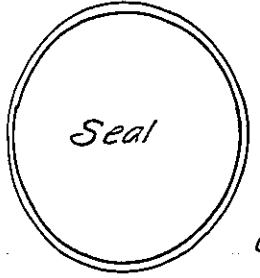


Pensilvania S.S.

At the Request of David Powel of Philad<sup>la</sup> Surveyor That we would grant him to take up One hundred and ~~fifty five~~ <sup>Seventy two</sup> Acres of Land in this Province in right and as part of Two hundred and fifty Acres the Original Purchase of Edward Edwards from ye Propriet<sup>rs</sup> in the Year One thousand Six hundred Eighty and one; These are to Authorize & Require thee to Survey and lay out to the S<sup>d</sup> David Powel or cause to be Survey'd & laid out the S<sup>d</sup> quantity of One hundred and ~~forty five~~ <sup>Seventy two</sup> Acres of <sup>Vacant</sup> Land on the Bounds of the Welch Tract next adjoining to that Tract which he has purchased of ~~Sam~~ the Attorneys or Agents for disposing of the Mannor of Mountjoy, And make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the Sixteenth day of the Sixth Month A.D. 1708.
