Whereas the Propriet' at his last Departure from this Province Granted unto David Powel of Philadelphia Survey': one Thousand Acres of Land to be taken up in the sd Province at the Rate or price of ten pounds p Hundred and the usual Yearly Quittance of one Shilling Sterling every ~~Hundred~~ Hundred Acres, Two Hundred of the Said Thousand Acres being already laid out to the Said David Powel the Remaining Eight Hundred Acres he now craves may be alsoe laid out to him, These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out <sup>or</sup> cause to be Survey'd and laid out unto the Said David Powel according to the Method of Townships appointed the Said Quantity of Eight Hundred Acres of Land in the Said Province that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by Indians and make a Returne there of into the Secretarys Office in Order to a further Confirmation, Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 28<sup>th</sup> day of the Sixth Month Anno Domini 1714 To Jacob Taylor Survey' Gen'
