Thousand Acres of Land in ye County of Philadelphia -

These are to will & require thee forthwth to Survey or cause to be
Surveyd unto Thomas Fitzwater Three hundred Acres of Land,
and One Thousand Seven hundred Acres for ye Widdow Palmer &
her Children in ye said County, where not already taken up according
to ye Method of Townships appointed by me, they seating & improving
ye same wthin One year from ye Date of ye Survey according
to Regulation, & make Returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 6 of ye 6th M^o 1684.
