

By vertue of a warrant from the Proprietary and Gov'n bearing Date the
 11th day of the 11th month 1709 - There was Resurveyd unto Samuel Baker
 heir of Henry Baker a Tract of Land in Wrights-Tow in the County of
 Bucks Laid out to ye Said Henry Baker for four hundred acres
 by Warrant from the Said Proprietaries Commiss^{rs} Beginning at a
 Corner marked white oak in the line of the Town Park or Square - Thence
 north fifty two Degrees West in the line of Thomas Colem^{as} land two
 hundred Sixty Seven perches to a Spanish oak over Randal's Creek
 Then North - oblique Parcels lands four hundred and nine perches to a
 Corner black oak oak Then South three hundred Seventy two
 perches to a post - Then South west by the town park one hundred
 and thirteen perches to the place of the beginning Containing ~~four~~^{four} hundred
 and thirty two acres to which there belongs fourteen acres per hundred
 VIZ^V fifty six acres in the Town Park or square - The Overplus beside allowance
 of ten P.C. is forty Eight acres - for which the said S Baker agrees to
 pay five Shillings p acres VIZ^V
