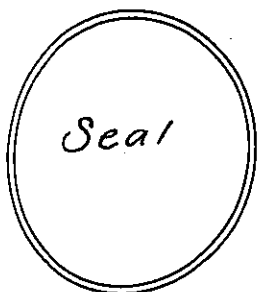

These are to Authorize and Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyd the Said Tract of Land according to its first Bounds and true Lines of Survey and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee Certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 23^d of the 12th moth 1701.
