

Pursuant to a warrant under the hand and Seal of the Proprietary and Governor bearing date the first day of the 12th month 1709
Granting unto Joseph Thatcher and his brother Bartholomew
(Executors of the will of Richard Thatcher old purchaser of one
thousand acres) a Survey on three hundred and fifty acres of
land in this province. There Survey'd unto Samuel Beaks purchaser
under said Joseph & Bartholomew a Tract of land in Soulberry
Township in the County of Bucks beginning at a Post by a black
oak at the Corner of Stephen Beaks his land from thence extend-
ing North West by Paul Wolf's & Thomas Garus land one hundred and
Seventy five perches to a Post from thence by Ezra Crossedals
land North east three hundred and twenty perches to a post
near a forked black oak from thence South East by Vacant land
175 to a black oak sapling from thence by Stephen Beaks's land
three hundred and twenty perches to the place of Beginning Containing
three hundred and fifty acres Survey'd by Jno Cutler the 15th
of the 8th month 1702.
