



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^s to me directed bearing date the 10th day of the fifth Month 1702. to Resurvey all the lands within the Townships of Bristol and Falls Resurveyed unto Anthony Burton a Tract of Land in Bristol Township in the County of Bucks. Beginning at a White Oak at William Biles Corner, Thence by the said Biles's line S.E. by E. 1 deg. E. 183 p: to a Post at John Burgess Corner, Then by the said Burgess land W. 30 deg. S. 144 perches to a Post. Then by Thomas Terry's land N.W. by W. 1 deg. W. 170 p: to a Post in Thomas Watson's line. Then by the said Watson and Solomon Warder's line N.E. by E. 143 perches to the place of beginning Containing 142 acres and three quarters of an acre. Resurveyed the 26th day of the 11th Month 1702.
