to Survey or cause to be resurveyd a certain parcel of Land in
Bristol in ye County of Bucks in ye possession of Thomas Yardly
and layout of ye Same his whole due there Viz fifty Acres together
With Allowance for Roads &c according to Law, also to layout
of the adjacent Land thirty Acres th like allowance as aforesd
yestd to Thomas Brook and the remaining Overplus that Shall be found
there, lay out for my use to be hereafter appropriated as I shall
see Cause, and make Returns hereof into my Secretaries Office.
