



By virtue of a Warrant from o.b. Proprietarys Comm^r to me directed beareing date the o.bith day of the first month 170 $\frac{1}{2}$ to execute all War^ts directed to Phineas Pemberton and not executed And pursuant to a Warr^t from Edward Penington Survey^r Gen^l to the Said Phineas Pemberton to Lay out unto Thomas Bye (in right of Several old purchasers) 600 acres in the County of Bucks Surveyed and Laid out unto the Said Thomas Bye a tract of land in Buckingham township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Corner marked black Oak at Richard Lundy's Corner, Thence by the Said Lundy's line N.W. 260 perches to an Elm tree at James Streators Corner, Then by the Sd Streators line N.E. 369 $\frac{1}{2}$ perches to a Post. Then S.E. by Jn^o Scarborough 260 perches to a Post. Then by Vacant Land S.W. 369 $\frac{1}{2}$ perches to the first mentioned black Oak, Containing 600 Acres and 70 perches, Laid out the 6th day of the 8th Month 1702.
