According to an order from the Surveyor General dated the 5th of this instant the 3rd month Resurveyed to Sam^l Dark part of that Tract of Land formerly layd out to Ann Milcome & now in possession of the said Dark by vertue of ~~the~~ Several Conveyances in the Custody of the said Dark whereby it may at large appeare how it has been transferred over to him, Begining at a Smal Maple ~~tree~~ Standing in a peice of Meadow land being the Cornor tree of the land that was formerly Philip Conways but now the land of Thomas Du^e from thence West North West five degrees, Northerly Ninety three pole to a Cornor marked White Oake thence West by the S^od land three hundered and Twenty pole to a Cornor marked Hickery thence North by the said land Twenty pole to a Cornor marked black Oake Thence West by the land of Henry Siddall one hundered and Sixty pole to a Cornor marked Maple Thence South by the land of Joseph Kirkbride One hundered & Ten pole to a Cornor marked Poppler ~~by the land of James Moone~~ thence East Three hundered & Ninety pole to a Cornor marked black oake Thence by the said Moones land East South East one hundered and fifty pole ~~at~~ Cornor Stake, (This line as I have said in the Draught varies in some places according to the marked Trees about five degrees Easterly) Thence North and by East five degrees Easterly to the first mentioned Cornor Tree Containing and layd out for Three hundered and forty acres Resurveyed p
