Surveyed and Laid out unto Jedidiah Allen, A Tract of Land in Soulberry Township in Bucks County Beginning at a Post by a Road being Paul Woolf's Corner, Thence by the said Woolf's line ^{NE} 320 per. to a Post at the other Corner, Then N.W. by Vacant Land 115 per. to a Post by a Spanish Oak, Then by Thomas Carus Land S.W. 320 per. to a Post by a black oak marked F.A. Then by the said Road S.E. 115 per. to the place of beginning Containing 230 Acres Surveyed and laid out the 29th day of the 3^d month 1702
