



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 18th / ^{3d} / ^{mo} 1703 to lay out unto Tobias Dymock and Sarah his Wife Relict of Nathaniel Hard in the quantity of 220 acres being the Remainder of the Sd Nathaniel Hardin's purchase of 500 Acres, Surveyed and laid out unto the Sd Tobias Dymock and Sarah his wife a tract of Land in Soulberry township in Bucks County, Beginning at a Post by a black ^{Oak} in James Logan's line, Thence by Randal Speakmans land North East one hundred and Nine perches to a Post, Then by Sd Speakman's land East One hundred forty one perches to a Post by a black oak, Then by Vacant land South four degrees East two hundred and twelve perches to a Post, Then by Vacant West Ninety four perches to a Post and a Stone in the Sd James Logan's line, Then by Sd line North West One hundred Ninety four perches to the place of beginning, Containing two hundred and twenty Acres Laid out the 13th / ^{4th} / ^{mo} 1704.
