


Pennsylvania S.S.



By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of William Blackfan the Proprietors Kinsman
that we w^{ld} grant him to take up within the Mⁿor of Highlands
in the County of Bucks the quantity of Two hundred acres of Land
for which he agrees to pay to the Said Propriet^rs use fforty Pounds
money of Pensilvania^a for the whole and the yearly quitrent of one shilling Sterling for
each Hundred Acres. These are to Authorize and Require thee to
Survey or Cause to be Surveyd unto the Said William Blackfan in
ye Said Mⁿor in one Ext^{re} Regular piece and with as little —
Injury to the remainder thereof as maybe. The Said quantity of
Two hundred acres of Land that has not been Surveyed to any
other person and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys
Office which Survey in case the Said William Blackfan fulfill
the above agreement within two years after ye date hereof
shall be Valid otherwise the Same is to be void as if it had
never been made nor this Warrant ever granted. Given under our
hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 30th day
of 7^{br} anno Domini 1718
