



By virtue of a Warrant of the Proprietary's Comm<sup>rs</sup> to me directed bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month 170 $\frac{1}{2}$  to execute all Warr<sup>ts</sup> directed to Phineas Pemberton and not executed, And also pursuant to a Warr<sup>t</sup> from Edw<sup>r</sup> Penington to the Said Phineas Pemberton dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of the 8<sup>th</sup> month 1701. Surveyed and laid out unto Randal Blackshaw a Tract of Land in Soulberry Township in Bucks County, Beginning at a Post by land for a Road being the Corner of Thomas Carus Land, Thence by the Said land N.E. 320. per. to a Post by a great Maple by a Run. Then by vacant land N.W. 250. per. to a Post and heap of Stones, Then by vacant land S.W. 320. per. to a Post, two Chains N.W. from the Bank of a Run, Then by land for a Road S.E. 250. per. to the place of beginning Containing 500 acres. Surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> day of the 3<sup>d</sup> month 1702.
