



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 18th 9th month 1715. Surveyed & Laid out unto Jeffrey Burgess at tract of Land in the Manner of Highlands in Bucks County Beginning at a Post by a Small Hickory in the Line of the London Company's Land fifty perches from John Pidcocks Corner from thence Extending West by the S^d. Line Two hundred perches to a Small white Oak, Then North One hundred & Sixty perches to a Small black Oak, Then East Two hundred perches to a Post, Then South (all by Highlands) One hundred & Sixty perches to the place of beginning Containing two hundred acres, Laid out the 16th day of the Second month Anno Domini 1716.
