



By virtue of a Warr<sup>t</sup> from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 29<sup>th</sup> day of the first month Anno: Dm: 1718 Surveyed & laid out unto Joshua Chessman a Certain tract of Land in Makefield in the County of Bucks Begining at a black Oak at a Corner of Joseph Milners Land, from thence runing West by the S<sup>d</sup> Milners Line 134 perches to a black Oak, Then by Thomas Stackhous Land North West 168 perches to a Post, Then by John Whittaker's Land East 180 perches to a Post, Then South by the S<sup>d</sup> Whittaker & William Mead's Land 75 perches to a Post, Then by the S<sup>d</sup> Mead's Land 74 perches to a Black Oak. Then by the S<sup>d</sup> Milner's Land South 42. perches to place of begining, Containing One hundred acres, Surveyed the Second day of the Sixth month Anno Domini 1718.
