



By virtue a Warrant from the Commission^{rs} of Property bearing date the 11th day of the 4th month 1712, Surveyed & laid out unto John Decow in right of his father Isaac Decow a small tract of Land near the great Swamp in the County of Bucks (adjoyning to two hundred acres before laid out in the Same Right) Beginning at a White Oak at a Corner of the other tract, Thence runing North twenty perches to another White Oak, Then East by Vacant lands 160 perches to a Small White oak, Then South 300 perches by vacant land to another White Oak, Then by vacant land West forty five perches & an half to a black oak, Then by the 5^d other tract North 280 perches to a Hickory tree, Then by the 5^d other tract West one hundred & fourteen perches & an half to the place of begining Containing one hundred acres, laid out the 27th day of the first month 1718. Given under my hand.
