By virtue of a Warrant from the Com<sup>rs</sup> of Property bearing date the 6<sup>th</sup> of the 2<sup>d</sup> month 1702, Resurveyed unto John Eastborn a tract of land in Southampton Township in Bucks County, Beginning at a Post by the Street being also a Corner of Thomas Cutlers land, Thence by the 5<sup>d</sup> Street North West Two hundred Sixty two perches to a Post, Then North East Three hundred Twenty two perches to a Post, Then South East One hundred perches to a Post, Then South West Two hundred Twenty two perches to a Post, Then South East One hundred fifty Seven perches to a Post, the four last Courses runing by John Naylor's land, Then by the 5<sup>d</sup> Thomas Cutlers land South West one hundred perches to the place of beginning, Containeing Three hundred & five acres, Resurveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> of the 7<sup>th</sup> month 1706. being the Second Time
