These are to require thee to Survey and lay out to the S<sup>d</sup> Ezra Crosdale, the S<sup>d</sup> Tract of vacant Land according to the Lines and Boundaries aforesaid, And make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warf<sup>t</sup> is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee Certified by the Secretary, Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 19<sup>th</sup> of the 3<sup>d</sup> Mo 1702.

This Warf<sup>t</sup> & the Survey thereon to be valid in case the S<sup>d</sup> Ezra comply w<sup>ch</sup> the aforesd Agreem<sup>t</sup> otherwise to be void and of no effect.
