



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaryes Comm<sup>r</sup>s to me directed bearing date the 19<sup>th</sup>/3<sup>d</sup> 1702 to Survey and lay out to Ezra Croasdale a certaine Tract of Vacant land Situate at the upper end of his Tract of 400 acres in newtown in the County of Bucks, bounded by the head line of the Said Land and of Wrightstown, for which he is to pay after the rate of 20<sup>t</sup> per hundred proportionably Laid out unto the sd Ezra Croasdale the said Tract, beginning at a Post at the Corner of his other land Thence by Joseph Wards land N.N.W. 42.p: to a Post in Wrightstown line, Then by the said Line N.E. 152.p: to a Small Hickery Then by ffrancis Richardson's land E. 21. degrees. S. 162. p. to a Post, Then S. 8 deg 64 p: to a small Hickery at Israel Morris Corner. Then by the sd Morris & Henry Paxson W. 21 deg 5' N 156 p: to a Post in the sd Ezra Croasdales line, Then by the same N. 17 deg 18 p: to a Post. Then S.W. 144. p: to the beginning, Containing Ninety acres. Surveyed the 8<sup>th</sup>/3<sup>d</sup> 1703.
