



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 19th / ^{3^d} / ^{mo} 1702 to Survey and lay out to Ezra Croasdale a certain Tract of Vacant land Situate at the upper end of his Tract of 400 acres in newtown in the County of Bucks, bounded by the head line of the Said Land and of Wrightstown, for which he is to pay after the rate of 20^{ty} hundred proportionably Laid out unto the Sd Ezra Croasdale the Said Tract, beginning at a Post at the Corner of his other land Thence by Joseph Ward's land N.N.W. 42 p: to a Post in Wrightstown line, Then by the Said Line N.E. 152 p: to a Small Hickery Then by Francis Richardson's land E. 21. degrees S. 162 p. to a Post, Then S. 8 deg^s E. by vacant 64 p: to a Small Hickery at Israel Morris Corner. Then by the Sd Morris & Henry Paxson W. 21 deg^s N 156 p. to a Post in the Sd Ezra Croasdales line, Then, by the Same N. 17 deg^s 18 p: to a Post. Then S.W. 144 p: to the beginning, Containing Ninety acres. Surveyed the 8th / ^{3^d} / ^{mo} 1703. By me John Cutler
