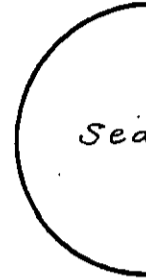

6th July 1759 The Surveyor General having Certified to me, that a Warrant granted to Nehemiah Allen on the 11th of February 1701. to take up three hundred Acres of Land, the remainder of his Father Nathaniel Allens Purchase of Two thousand Acres has never been executed, that he can find by the most diligent Search in his Office, Jam of Opinion that he should execute or cause the same to be executed to Nehemiah Allen, John Allen, Nathaniel Allen, Joseph Allen, Mary Richardson, Wife of Joseph Richardson Goldsmith and Hannah Allen the Children of and Representatives and residuary Legatees of Nathaniel Allen deceased who was intituled to the sd Land as Residuary Legatee of his Father to whom the said Warrant was granted
