At the Request of Israel Pemberton That we would Grant him to take up in the Liberties of Philad^a the Proportion of Liberty Land belonging to two hundred & fifty acres, the original purchase of John Brown made of the Propriet^ry by Deeds of Lease & Release dated ye 22^d & 23^d days of the first Month Anno Din 1681.

The Right to which said Liberty Land being now vested in the said Israel These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be surveyd unto the said Israel Pemberton in the said Liberty's the said proportion of Liberty Land if there to be found Vacant and clear of all former Surveys and make exact Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office in order for a further Confirmation.

Given under our hands & the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 25th day of the first month Anno Din 1719
