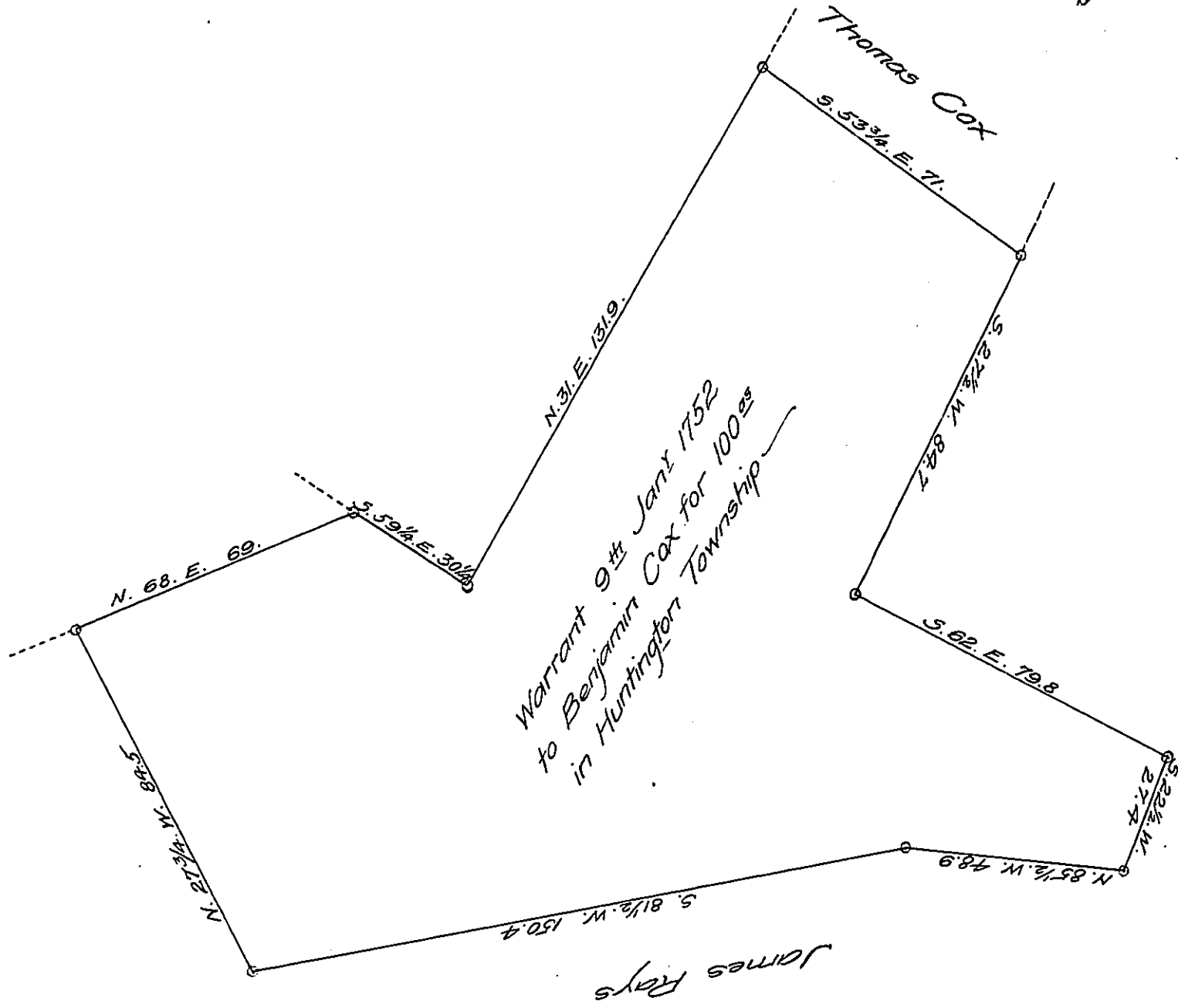

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government I have this day located & surveyed Warrant issued 9<sup>th</sup> January 1752 to Benjamin Cox for 100<sup>ac</sup> in Huntington Township, on Lands partly in Huntington & Tyrone Townships, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram
