Upon an agreement made with William Marsh of the County of Chester for three hundred Acres of Land where he is seated at or near the head of Otteraroe in y^e said County for which he is to pay to y^e Proprietors use forthwith after Survey Thirty pounds and three Years Quitrent before y^e Grant hereof at one Shilling Sterling for each hundred & after y^e same Rate for ever hereafter. These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be surey'd to the said William Marsh the said quantity of three hundred Acres of Land in the place afores^d in one regular Tract adjoining on the Neighbouring Surveys and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Which Survey in case the sd William comply with the aforesaid Agreement or pay or secure y^e paym^t of y^e said Money within three Months at farthest after the Date hereof, shall be valid otherwise the same shall be void, as if it had never been made, nor this warr^t ever Granted.
